It's on again Flyballers! The Sydney Royal Easter Show being held at its usual venue of Olympic Park, Homebush. This year the AFA have again been invited to bring Flyball along to be a major part of the entertainment in the Overflow area and as we did last year, we'll be running two competitions and providing demo's on three other days

On Friday April the 2nd we will run the one day Good Friday Flyball Flurry again and on Easter Saturday and Sunday, April 3rd and 4th there will be the two day Supercoat Challenge Cup competition. Easter Monday (April the 5th) and the Saturday and Sunday April 10th and 11th will have Flyball demonstrations during the days. So far we have the following clubs arranging the events
