Competition Race Format:

- o Division 1
 - Double round robin (4 teams – 6 races each team - Best 3 of 5)
- o Division 2
 - Double round robin (4 teams – 6 races each team – Best 3 of 5)
- o Division 3
 - Triple round robin (3 teams – 6 races each team - Best 3 of 5)
- o Divisions 4
 - Double round robin (4 teams – 6 races each team - Best 3 of 5)
- o Divisions 5
 - Double round robin (5 teams – 8 races each team – 3 Heats)
- o Points for round robin will be allocated as follows:
 - 2 points for winning the race,
 - 1 point for a drawn race,
 - 0 points for a loss.
- o In the event of a tied placing, there will be a **count back** as per the AFA rules & regulations
- o All heats are to be contested.
- o In the event of a team forfeiting a race the team left to run by itself must complete a minimum of three heats to claim points for a win. If the team does not complete three heats, zero points will be awarded.



Stewarding

All teams are requested to participate in stewarding throughout the day to ensure the smooth running of the competition.

Rules & Regulations

- o All Competitors must ensure dogs are on lead when not racing and all dog faeces are disposed of in the appropriate manner.
- o All racing will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Australian Flyball Association.

Breakouts

Break Out time will be one (1) second faster than the fastest seedtime for each division (except Division I). Where a declared seed time has been submitted the breakout time will 1 second faster than the declared time.

When manual judging is used (in the absence or failure of the Electronic Judging System), the Break Out time will be two (2) seconds faster than the fastest seedtime for each division (except Division 1).

Penalty for first and second break out for the same team in a competition will result in forfeit of each heat in question.

Should a team break out three (3) times in a single competition, the penalty will be exclusion from placing in their division for the competition.

Changeover Times

Teams will have 90 seconds from the end of the proceeding race to have their box and jumps set up and be ready to race. The judge will indicate when there is thirty seconds remaining. The judge may forfeit a team if they are not ready on time. If we are running behind time then the changeover time may change to 60 seconds.

Catering

Catering will be available at stalls participating in the Castle Hill Show. There will be a 1 hour lunch break.
