Rules for Singles and Pairs Racing – 2019 Championships

Friday 27th September 2019 Entries Close: Monday 29th July 2019

Entry fee: \$10 per dog for Singles racing and \$20 per team for Pairs racing.

Only dogs with at least 5 AFA points at the time of close of entries are eligible to enter the Singles or Pairs racing. NO BEGINNERS SINGLES

Dogs in Pairs teams do not have to be from the same club. The club to be nominated on the Pairs entry form can be either handler's if they are from different clubs

Singles and Pairs Racing -

- Dogs must be over 1 year of age
- Handlers must be financial members of the AFA and dogs must have a current CRN
- Open Singles and Pairs Classes are open to AFA Registered dogs that have at least 5 AFA Title Points as of the entry closing date
- All AFA rules apply NO title points are given for this event.
- Dogs can be entered in Open Singles and / or OPEN Pairs racing
- Dogs entered in the OPEN competitions on the same day (Friday) are not eligible to race in Singles or Pairs
- Singles racing will be based on AFA rules for height of nominated dog - i.e. between 7 and 14 inches
- The height dog in the pair will determine pairs jump heights.
- Racing will be round robin
- One false start per handler per heat will be allowed.
- In Pairs racing, one rerun per team per heat will be allowed for early passing
- A declared seedtime must be entered for both Singles and Pairs.
- Breakout time will be 0.25 secs faster for Singles and 0.50 sec faster for Pairs than the declared seedtime.
- Racing will be in Divisions based upon seed time splits
- Competitors may use their own box or supplied boxes will be available.
