

AFA – COVID update – December 2020.

State Governments are now progressively reviewing and relaxing restrictions imposed as part of the Australian Coronavirus safety plan. Most internal border restrictions have now been withdrawn and Australians are generally free to travel between States. We are now entering what is becoming known as the post Covid norm. With the easing of restrictions it is now possible for Clubs throughout Australia to resume flyball training and to plan flyball events for 2021.

It is still necessary for Clubs and members to recognise the need to continue to comply with any restrictions imposed by State Governments, local authorities or ground hirers. Maintaining social distancing, adopting good hand hygiene, and getting tested and/or self-isolating if any symptoms or contact concerns exist are all still requirements of ensuring we remain in control of the post covid environment. Where required, wearing of masks and attendance registration requirements should also be observed.

Whilst the Committee will continue to monitor covid developments each month we look forward to the resumption of flyball activity in 2021 and simply remind all clubs and members of the need to monitor local conditions and comply with any restrictions/requirements imposed by State or local authorities.
