Rule Notification FY2425-3 - Height cards

At its meeting on 6 January 2025 the AFA committee, acting on the recommendation of the rules sub-committee, resolved to amend the rules relating to applications for height cards. Changes to the rules are set out below. They will be effective from 1 July 2025 and will be included in the next published version of the rules.

Background

The rules sub-committee reviewed the current process for obtaining height cards and noted that the rules:

- allow for completion of two separate height card application forms,
- do not require a dog to be of a minimum age to be measured for a height card,
- do not restrict a measuring judge from witnessing a second measure.

The sub-committee considered that:

- it would be appropriate to introduce a minimum age for one of the measures to ensure that a dog had fully grown,
- the current rules could be open to manipulation.

As a result, the sub-committee recommended to the AFA committee that the rules should be amended so that:

- both measures for a height card must be recorded on a single application form,
- a dog must be at least two years old at the time of one of the measures.
- each measure must be carried out by a different judge and witnessed by an official not involved with the other measure.

Rule Changes

Amend rule 8.3

The first and third paragraphs of rule 8.3 are amended as shown by tracking below:

Height cards are optional. A dog's **owner** may apply for a **height card** by submitting a completed **height card application form**, together with the prescribed fee, to the **AFA committee**.

The process for obtaining a completed *height card application form* is set out in Appendix 11.

After the *height card application form* is verified by the *AFA committee*, a *height card* will be issued.

Replace Part 2 of Appendix 11

Part 2 of Appendix 11 is replaced with:

The following is the process for obtaining a completed *height card application form* for a dog:

- the dog must be measured twice at the same height,
- the two measures may be done at one race meeting or separate race meetings,
- the dog must be over two years old at the time of at least one of the measures,
- the dog may only be measured at a *race meeting* in which the dog is entered,
- the dog must be measured in accordance with rule 8.1 by a *judge* officiating at the *race meeting*,
- the *height card application form* must be presented to the measuring *judge* before the dog is measured,
- each measure must be done by a different judge,
- each measure must be witnessed by another judge or a registered AFA representative,
- the witness to a measure need not be officiating at the *race meeting* but must not be the measuring *judge* or witness for the other measure,
- the height card application form must be completed for each measure and signed by the measuring judge, the witness to the measure and the dog's owner.

Note: For each measure at least one of the measuring **judge** or the witness must not be a member of the same **club** as the dog's **owner**.
